Herb Haller will be entering his eleventh season in the fall as Head Coach of the boy's varsity soccer team at Western Reserve Academy. WRA has compiled an impressive 171-61-43 record at his alma mater, where he was a two-time high

school All-American. The National Soccer Coaches Association of America named Haller the 2006 Private/ Parochial School Regional Coach of the Year. He was the 2006 and 2005 Greater Akron Scholastic Soccer Coaches Association Private/Parochial School Coach of the Year. In 2004 he won the GASSCA Ron Pinsenschaum Award, given to the coach who exemplifies sportsmanship, integrity, and the development of character and positive values on the field. Before returning to WRA, Haller spent four seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Akron, helping guide them to a 51-21-6 overall record, three MAC championships and an NCAA tournament birth in 1998. He holds a US Soccer Federation 'A' Coaching License, is an Olympic Development Program Region II Coach, as well as an Olympic Development Program State Team Head Coach, and is a State Coaching School Instructor.

Haller played college soccer at Indiana University, captaining the 1988 team to the Hoosiers third NCAA National Championship in their storied history.
